

Libel understanding

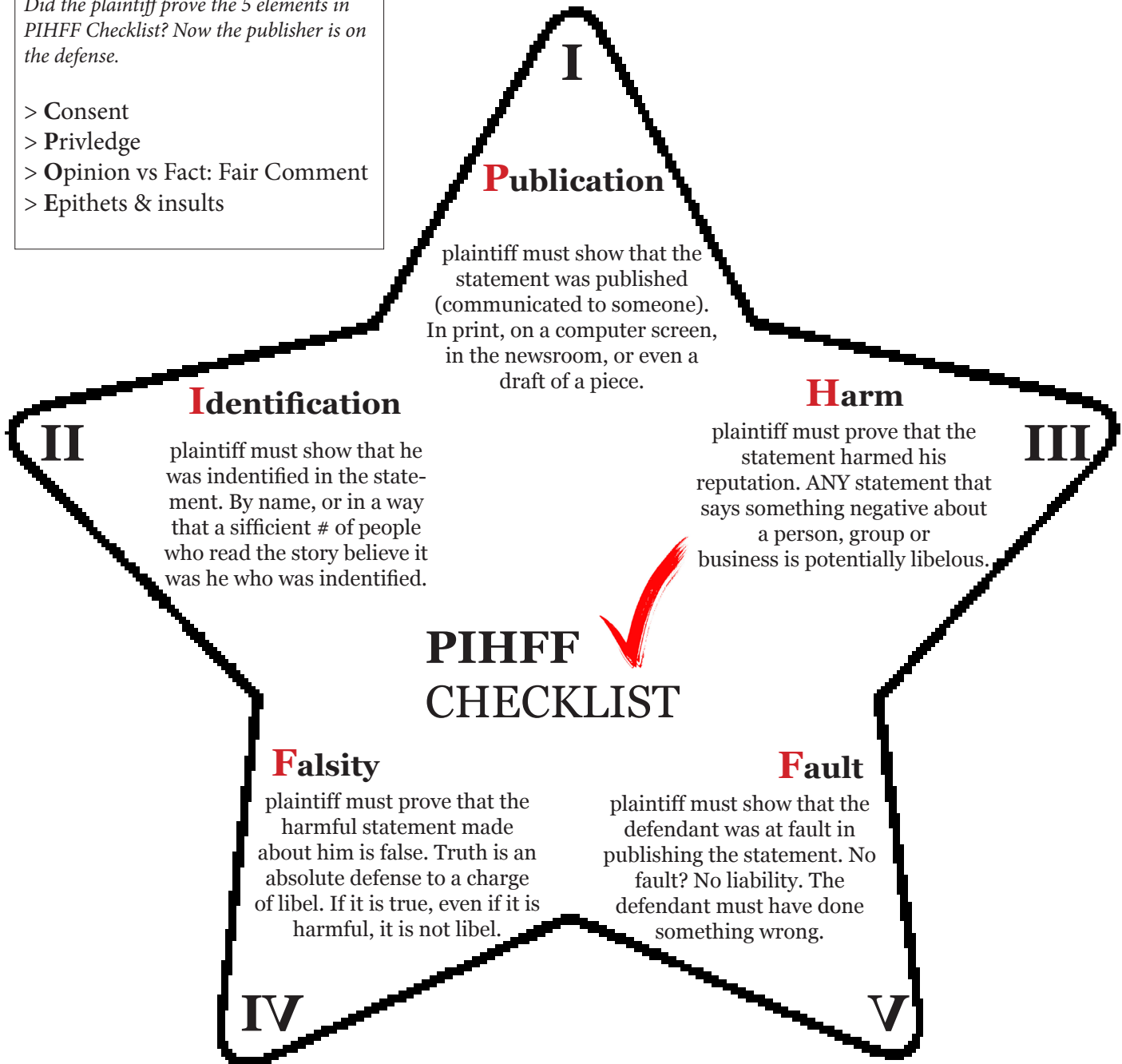


li·bel [lahy-buhl] *noun* 1. Law. Defamation by written or printed words, pictures, or in any form other than by spoken words or gestures.

Any published communication- words, photos, pictures, symbols - that **falsely** harms a person's reputation.
